

MAY 2017 Electronics Recycling Competition!

What: This May, all elementary (or K8) schools in Eugene/Springfield are invited to participate in an electronics recycling competition.

- Schools must register in March or April to participate. (The first 16 schools to register get a special container and "pick-up week" at their school, so **apply now!**)
- NextStep will accept anything that has a plug, or takes batteries (including: old working or broken electronics; toys, cell phones, monitors, computer and phone cables, etc.).

How to donate: There are 2 ways to donate working or non-working electronics for the competition:

- 1) Donate directly at NextStep during the month of May.** When you drop off your electronics, tell them the name of the school you would like your donation to credit, and NextStep will add it to that school's total collected pounds. (Drop off location: 2101 W. 10th Avenue, Eugene.)
- 2) Drop off donations directly at school.** For one week in May, eligible schools will have a large collection box located onsite that NextStep will pickup. (Please choose preferred dates using our online registration form.)
